- 5 Unfinished/ Old Business –
 - a. Certification by Chief Firearms Officer - signs to be posted on newly established boundary.
 - b. Gate installation - design and estimate approved. Location agreed; awaiting installation.
 - c. Range Safety Officer Training, any updates
 - d. Board Membership - Pierre Gadbois volunteered to act as Club Secretary; handover with Paul Fairclough under way. Item closed.

e. “Future of Club” Strategy; marketing campaign pilot - shotgun lessons ongoing; Youth Hunt Camp 2026 completed; 2027 Atlantic Outdoor Show, booth space allocated. Locke’s Lifestyle, Sporting & Outdoor Adventures - after discussion with Locke’s and based on the current retail situation in the Maritime provinces, it was jointly agreed to suspend our sponsorship relationship but maintain a close working arrangement. Archery section relaunch completed.

f. Grants/Sources of Funding - accessibility project; grant application unsuccessful. Project deferred for 2027 review.

h. Capital Projects Review - Seacan purchased, boundary survey completed. Gate installation to be completed.

j. Club tool crib/machinery - green shed beside skeet field could be used for the tool crib.

k. Fire prevention / Fire Fighting protocol to be developed. Water totes obtained; placement and use to be discussed with Riverport Fire Department.

l. Extension of 100 yard parking lot - scope review held with Rifle & shotgun section reps and club member Jake Langley who agreed to provide a cost estimate and schedule for the work.

m. Riverport Connector Project (Kingsburg Coastal Conservancy) - following a presentation at the last members’ meeting by Robert Meyer, it was agreed that LRGC would provide representation on the KCC Advisory Council. The presentation material will be distributed to the membership.

n. 5-stand range relocation - following the recent extension of the Sporting Clay field to 15 stands, clay throwers from the 5-stand range were transferred to the Sporting Clay field. In order to optimize machine useage, the 5-stand range will be relocated between existing sporting clay stands 1 and 2. Significant work will be required to achieve this so 5-stand will be shutdown until the early new year. CFO approval of the new location will be required.
